

Jesus Is the Vine John 15:1-17



Here's what happens...

Jesus describes his relationship with us using a plant metaphor. He says he is the vine and we're the branches. As we remain attached to him, like branches are attached to a tree, his love grows in us and we produce good fruit!

Bible Point:

Jesus is the vine, so we grow in his love.

"Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing" (John 15:5).

Family Together Time

- Buy a cut flower, cut one from your garden, or pick a leaf.
- Watch what happens to the flower or leaf during the week.
- Jesus said, "Apart from me you can do nothing" (John 15:5). How does the cut flower or leaf remind you of that?
- Look at a potted plant or a tree outside. (If it's winter, use an evergreen tree so it doesn't appear dead!) Compare that with the cut flower or leaf.
- Talk about ways your family can remain rooted in Jesus' love.
